Highgate Counselling Centre

Individual counselling, either on a short-term (up to 12 sessions) or long-term basis (up to two years), involves meeting with a counsellor on a weekly basis over a period of time which is determined by the nature of the problem. A contribution fee of £60 is payable towards the cost of the initial consultation. For on-going counselling, they ask that clients make a financial contribution to cover the costs of each scheduled session. The exact amount will be agreed between you and your counsellor at the beginning of your counselling.
